SAFE KITING GUIDELINES

Kitesurfing is easy to practice safely with a little forethought and common sense. Ultimately we are responsible for minimising the risk to ourselves, and others, which will help protect the future of this great sport – be very CLEAR about your responsibilities.

CLEAR

CONDITIONS

- wind strength
- wind direction
- always keep downwind area well clear
- waves, tides and currents
- consider possible changes

LOOK

- before you launch, land, jump, jibe, etc.

EQUIPMENT

- always complete a pre-flight check
- use a kite leash
- use a quick release on anything you hook into
- practise using your safety systems regularly so that it becomes instinctive
- never exceed manufacturers specifications

ATTITUDE

- always seek and listen to local advice
- do not exceed your limitations
- use judgement to prevent situations, do not rely on skill to try and get out of it

RESPECT

- others - be considerate and courteous to all other water and beach users
- the law
- fellow kilters - follow right of way rules
- the environment
